Create an Account

1. Go to gladyskellylibrary.beanstack.org OR download the Beanstack app on your phone.
2. Click "Register an Individual or a Family"
3. If you would like your child to have their own account, then you may select "I am registering myself". We recommend that children under 12 are listed under a parent account, for supervision purposes. In this case we suggest you select "I am an adult registering a child."
4. Fill in the information
 - a. You must fill in all required categories, the rest is optional.
5. Select the correct Reading Challenge
 - a. There is only one currently!
6. If you are registering an individual, you will be done registering!
7. If you are registering a family, at this point you can add more readers.

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Badges Types and How to Earn Them

- There are four kinds of badges: Challenge badges, Logging Badges, Activity Badges, and Review Badges.
- **Challenge Badges:** These badges are earned by signing up for and completing a challenge. These are automatically awarded to you!
- **Logging Badges:** These are badges which are earned by logging TIME reading. This program is based on time spent reading. (Not pages or number of books completed.)
 - You will automatically be awarded these badges as you log your minutes.
- **Activity Badges:** These are badges which are earned by completing some or all of the activities listed. In this reading program, these badges challenge readers to come visit the library and participate in our programming.
 - To earn these badges you must select the badge and then check the box saying you completed the activity.
 - You may be prompted to answer a question about the activity you attended. Answer this question to get your badge.
- **Review Badges:** These are badges earned by writing reviews of books on the website.
 - There is no requirement for length of review
 - You will automatically be awarded these badges after you leave a review.



Logging Reading

1. In the upper left corner select “Log Reading and Activities”
2. Select “Minutes”
3. Select the correct day and then record how many minutes were spent reading.
4. You may choose to input book information, but it is NOT required.

Writing Reviews

1. When you log your reading, you may add a review. You can also edit later to add a review!
2. You may submit picture reviews; this can be a great way to have your young child post a review as a drawing or handwritten review.

Logging Activity Badges

1. Click the “Activity Badges” tab
2. Click on a badge to see the details of the badge
3. Badges will list the number of activities, but most badges do NOT require that you complete all the activities but only a few of them.
4. You must mark off the activities as you complete them.

Finishing the Program

- To finish the program, and be awarded the badge for completing, you must log 10 hours of reading.
- If you complete the program you will have earned two book prizes.

Prizes

- Badges may come with no reward, a raffle ticket, or prize reward.
 - In the corner of unearned badges you will see a small trophy image if earning the badge earns you a prize
 - In this reading program logging 5 hours and 10 hours will earn you a prize.
- To see the prizes, you have earned/can earn, scroll the tab bar over to see “Rewards”
 - Prizes are available for pick up at the Youth Services desk in the Children’s room of the library
 - For this challenge the prizes are books! You will get to choose which book you want, when you come to pick it up.
